Beware of Phishing-Mails!

Recognize fraudulent e-mails and
prevent data misuse.

Fake sender address

Is the sender's e-mail address correct?
Can the sender confirm sending?

Request for credentials

Phishing e-mails often ask you
to disclose access data.

Linguistic inaccuracies

Suspicious e-mails often contain
spelling mistakes.

Links to fake websites

Check links in e-mails first: Place the mouse
pointer on the link without clicking (hover).

Urgency

Does the e-mail signal urgency
or an acute need for action?

Attachments

Never open files attached
of a suspicious e-mail.
